

Before even finishing this book, I wanted to rave about its author's accomplishment. As a former art history professor, a constant visitor to Paris(I lived there two summers and a full year as a Fulbright professor), and deeply read about the occupation years, I have long wanted to know how the French protected their art, where they sent it, how they maintained it throughout the occupation. Ms. Chanel has answered so many of my questions and she has done so beautifully. The book is extremely well written, intriguing, perfectly paced, and boasts many photos the reader may never have seen. I loved her mercifully short chapters, jewellike. I also admired the thoroughness with which she presents her story and places it in the wider context of the war. I was especially impressed to learn of the extent to which Jaujard, the director of the Louvre, stood up not only to the Nazis but also to the collaborationist French who seemed willing to turn the national treasure over to Hitler, et al. This is a wonderful book!
